Attendance

You are required to attend each Ambassador meeting. Meetings are held at a designated time decided by the Ambassador team. If you are unable to attend you must notify the Extension Office prior to the meeting if possible; if not, immediately following. You are allowed one absence.

Leadership Training

Attending District 11 Junior Leadership Lab, during the summer, is encouraged but not required.

Dress Code

Ambassador green polo shirt, nice jeans/khaki pants, appropriate shoes.

Record Book

To participate you can submit a 4-H record book. Books must be submitted by the deadline set by the Extension Office.

OR

Community Service Hours

If you do not submit a 4-H record book, you can document 20 hours of community service. You will turn in those hours when you submit your ambassador application.

Promote 4-H

You are required to promote 4-H during the first full week in October, celebrated as National 4-H Week. Also, to assist with planning and coordination of the annual 4-H Kick-off held at the beginning of every new 4-H year and the annual 4-H Achievement Night at the end of the year; as well as to attend various Open House opportunities within the school district with senior ambassadors.
